Proposal

That Clause 7 of the Constitution shall be amended with the following:

The general management of the Association shall be vested in a Committee elected annually by the members of the Association. Such Committee members shall be members of the Association.

The Committee shall consist of a minimum of six and a maximum of sixteen people.

The Committee shall include the following Primary Officers:

- a Chairman,
- a Secretary
- a Treasurer

The Committee may assign to individual Committee members additional Officer roles including, but not limited to the following:

- (e) a Website/Membership Database Manager,
- (f) a Match Secretary,
- (g) a Competitions Secretary,
- (h) a Chief Tournament Director,
- (i) a Communications Officer.

As long as they are re-elected each year, there is no limitation on the length of time any individual may remain on the Committee, although the Chairman shall not hold this office for more than five consecutive years.

The Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancies that occur through resignation or otherwise and to co-opt members to the Committee; any such co-opted members shall retain this status until the next annual general meeting

The Committee may appoint sub-committees as required; delegate to them such powers and duties as may be deemed expedient; and disband them if and when they have served their purpose. Sub-committee members must be members of the Association, but are not required to be members of the main Committee
