The Qualifying Round for the Championship Pairs will be scored overall, with approximately the top quarter qualifying for the Championship Final (Committee Cup), the second quarter for the Consolation Final (Markwell Trophy) and the remainder for the Open Pairs (Suffolk Coastal Council Shield).

### Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> October – Swiss Teams 11.00 start

15.00	4 x 7 board matches
15.00	Relaxed Pairs (finish around 18.00)
19.00	Presentation of Pairs & Swiss Teams prizes
19.30	Projected finish

The winning team will be awarded the David Price Trophy. The highest-placed team that does not include a player of National Master rank or above will be awarded the Jack Barnard Trophy.

**Cash prizes** will be awarded to the section winners (Pairs qualifying), top three or four in each of the Finals, best-placed Pair and Team not including a player of National Master rank or above, and Ascenders (Teams). The total prize fund will be at least £1500.

There is a separate 'Relaxed Pairs' section on the Sunday with cash prizes and reduced entry fee for inexperienced players with 2500 Local Masterpoints or fewer and an NGS rank of 8 or lower.
